The Tour kicks off in two weeks - at the Grande Prairie Stompede May 30-June 2 with stops across Western Canada over the course of the CPRA season. The Tour Finals is set for September 1 in Armstrong B.C. where athletes will compete for \$12,000 per event, double the payout of last year. The final Tour rodeo also in Armstrong, at the IPE and Stampede takes place the Labour Day weekend.

New rodeos on the 2019 Tour include Grande Prairie and the Teepee Creek Stampede in Alberta July 12-14 and Pile O’ Bones Rodeo in Regina, Saskatchewan August 2-4. For those fans who cannot attend in person, FloRodeo will be live-streaming all Finning Pro Tour events. www.florodeo.com
