

## **Asset Groups in Asset Monitoring App**

The Asset Monitoring application includes an asset grouping feature where an individual user can assign assets in their company equipment list to a custom group and be able to share that group with other users in their company.

The grouping function assigns a unique tag to an asset serial number based on the criteria selected by the user.

# What's Changed?

- 1. The location. There is no longer a column in the grid view. It is now always accessible and is located at the top left of the screen.
- 2. A single asset can now be assigned to multiple groups.
- 3. The ability to share Asset Groups. Users with Customer Admin or Finning Admin permissions can now share their groups with others.
- 4. How to assign assets to a group you can no longer pre-select assets to a group.
- 5. Settings have been adjusted to unlock an asset group so other users with permissions (Customer or Finning Admin) can also edit groups.





# **Asset Group Tips and Feature Rules**

- An asset can be assigned to multiple groups.
- There is no audit log showing users when changes were made to a group, or by who.

#### Asset Groups are:

- · unique to each individual user.
- unlocked when created. You must navigate to settings to "unlock" the group to make changes.
- **static.** Dynamic groups that add and remove serial numbers based on changing asset characteristics such as location, hours, health status, etc. are not supported at this time.
- · shareable within your organization.
  - Users with administrative access can create and share asset groups with other users who have a CUBIQ
    account within their company.

# **Step-By-Step Instructions**


In the **Asset Monitoring app**, you can create, view, edit or share your asset groups.

- 1. The first level of the All Assets ellipsis menu provides access to:
  - Add New create a new asset group
  - My Groups view your groups and filter to view an asset group
  - Shared view which groups have been shared with you

- 2. The second level of your All Assets saved asset group ellipsis menu provides access to:
  - Rename rename an asset group
  - Share share an asset group with someone in your company (company or Finning admins only)
  - Remove delete an asset group
  - Setting manage assets, access and group settings (view and administer settings
    - Owner identifies who the owner of the group is
    - Edit Settings lock / unlock group settings
    - Group Name another way to rename the group
    - o Serial Number add or remove assets (serial numbers) from the group
    - Share Group share groups with other people in the org

### **Create A New Asset Group**

1. Click the All Assets ellipsis menu and select Add New




Select Add New

2. Enter an Asset Group Name that is easily identifiable to you



Enter an Asset Group Name

3. Expand the Serial number drop down list, select the Serial number(s) you would like to add to the Asset Group and click Save. You will receive a toast message indicating the group has been created. See tips to adding serial numbers below.

**Note:** At any time after the group is set up, you can add or remove assets from the group.




Serial number is the only way to add an asset to a group. The first 3 columns will be blocked by the "Create New Group" box which cannot be moved.

We recommend that you:

- Record the serial numbers you want in a group ahead of time OR 1.
- Visually filter the serial numbers in the grid view first. Position the Asset ID and Serial Number columns to the 4th and 5th column position to see what serial number(s) to select. Other pertinent data can be moved over as well.

#### Serial Number Search and Selection

- 1. Select the serial number by scrolling through the list OR
- 2. Enter the first few characters into the search box and select the asset

## Edit an Existing Group - Add or Remove Assets

1. To add or remove assets to an existing group, select the asset group you want to edit and select Setting.



Select Setting to edit Asset Group






- 2. A **Settings** window will pop-up where you can make changes to the asset group add, delete, change the group name, or share the group with others within your company.
  - Add assets either by selecting the serial number from the list in the drop-down menu or typing
    the serial number in the search bar

• Remove assets by clicking the X on the serial number button.



Click X to remove Asset from Group


3. When edits are complete, click Save.






### **Delete an Asset Group**

1. When viewing your asset group, click **Remove** to delete the group.



Select Remove to delete Asset Group

2. A pop-up window will appear confirming you want to delete the group. Click Confirm.

# **Shared Asset Groups**

### **Share an Asset Group**


Company Administrators can create and share groups with others who have a CUBIQ account within their company.

1. When viewing your asset group, click **Share**.



Remove Asset from Group

2. Enter the name of the person you want to share the asset group with and select the **name** from the menu. Click **Save**. **Note:** It is possible to add more than one employee or division in a single step.

3. The asset group will now have an icon as a visual indicator that the group has been shared.




Visual Indicator that Group is Shared



## **Edit or Remove a Shared Asset Group**

Company Administrators can remove shared groups from others within their company. **Note:** As a recipient of the Shared Group, it is not possible to remove the shared group.

1. When viewing your asset group, click **Setting** to edit the group.

2. Remove shared group by clicking the  ${\bf X}$  on the contact or division. Click  ${\bf Save}$ .




Click X to remove shared group



### View who an Asset Group was Shared With

1. To view who the asset group was shared with, click **Setting**.

2. In the **Settings** window the users who were shared the group are listed in **green** under **Share Group**.




## **View all My Asset Groups**

Once the Asset Group(s) have been set up, they are viewable and filterable. When selecting an Asset Group to view, the search results filter to the individual group only.


 To view the asset groups <u>you created</u>, click the All Assets ellipsis drop down and select the Group under My Groups. When selecting an Asset Group to view, the search results filter to the individual group only.





View my Asset Groups

To view the asset groups shared with you, click the All Assets ellipsis drop down and select the Asset Group under Shared.



View Shared Groups

**Note:** Only a single group or all assets can be selected to be viewed at any one time. Viewing multiple asset groups simultaneously is <u>not possible</u>.

#### **Reset to All Assets View**

1. When viewing your asset group, click All Assets to remove the filter to see the entire asset list.




Click All Assets to remove Asset Group filter

#### **Edit Asset Group Settings**

Settings is where you can make changes to the asset group, group settings and manage assets - add, delete, change the group name, or share the group with others within your company.


1. When viewing your asset group, click **Setting** to edit the group. A **Settings** window will pop-up where you can make changes to the asset group.



Select Setting to Edit Asset Group


- 2. **Owner.** Identifies who the owner of the group is. This is <u>not</u> an editable option.
- 3. Lock / Unlock the Asset Group. Located under Edit Settings, toggle to lock or unlock the group.

4. **Group Name.** Another way to rename the group. Edit the **Group Name** and click **Save**.



Lock / Unlock the Group


- 5. **Serial Number.** Add or remove assets (serial numbers) from the group. See Edit an Existing Group Add or Remove Assets instructions above.
- 6. **Share Group.** Share groups with other people in the org. See <u>Edit or Remove a Shared Asset Group</u> instructions above.



## **Troubleshooting**

• I selected an asset group to view but no assets are showing.

The filter rules in the other columns of the table are <u>still enforced when an asset group is used</u>. If you select an asset group and see no results check to see if filters are set in any of the other columns. To clear the filters, click the circular X at the top left of the Asset List table.

- I pre-selected assets but they were not selected when I created the group.
  - When creating an asset group pre-applied filters are remembered but pre-selection of assets using the check box is not. For example: if you filter to assets with expired warranties and create a new group and add assets with both valid and expired warranties, when you view your group it will only show assets in the group that have expired warranties (because of the filters pre-applied).
- I changed companies but the asset group from my last company still shows but with no assets are showing.
  - This is a known issue. When a user changes company's and has groups shared from the previous company, the shared group remains in their view but with no asset data.
